4. Qualifications are as per First Statutes of Chaudhary Charan Singh University Meerut and as per UGC Regulations 2018 dated 18 July 2018 and U.P. Govt. Notification dated 28 June 2019 (for University Teachers).
5. Eligibility is according to Governor order Ref. No-E-4229/GS, Dated 02 July, 2021.
6. The prescribed application fee (Rs. 1000/- for UR & OBC) is to be paid online.
7. Printout of online application form duly completed in all respects along with self attested documents is to be submitted by Registered/Speed post addressed to the Registrar, Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut (U.P.) - 250004, India. It is mandatory to mention Advertisement No., Post, Subject and Category.
8. Applicants should clearly note that the University will, in no case, be responsible for non-receipt of their applications or any delay in receipt thereof. Applications received after the last date shall not be entertained. Applicants should, therefore, ensure that their applications reach the University on or before the last date.
9. Reservations will be applicable as per U.P. State Government norms/rules. Other states OBC/SC/ST/EWS candidates would be treated as General Category candidates.

ELIGIBILITY & OTHER RELEVANT PROVISIONS FOR RECRUITMENT

1.1 General Eligibility Criteria for Assistant Professor

- 1.1.1 Good academic record as defined by the State Government with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- 1.1.2 Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- 1.1.3 Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (1.1.1) and (1.1.2) to this Clause, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
- 1.1.4 NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.



2. Other Relevant Provisions for Recruitment

- 2.1 A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) will be required at the Master's degree level with good academic record for those candidates to be recruited as teachers at any level from industries and research institutions and at the entry level of Assistant Professor;
Provided that a relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- 2.2 The minimum requirements of a good academic record is Second Division at Graduate degree level, 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the master's degree level and qualifying in the National Eligibility Test (NET), or an accredited test (State Level Eligibility Test - SLET/SET), shall remain for the appointment of Assistant Professor.
- 2.3 A relaxation of 5% shall be provided at the graduate and master's degree level for the posts reserved for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- 2.4 Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.
- 2.5 The Ph.D. Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for the appointment of Professor and Associate Professor.
- 2.6 The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
- 2.7 The Selection Committee specifications as provided in section 31 of the Act are applicable to all direct recruitments of faculty positions.
- 2.8 Percentage equivalence of grade points for a seven points scale: Where the University/College/Institution declare results in grade points which is on a scale of seven, the following mechanism shall be referred to ascertain equivalent marks in percentage:

A-Under UGC norms -

Grade	Grade Point	Percentage Equivalent
'O' - Outstanding	5.50-6.00	75-100
'A' - Very Good	4.50-5.49	65-74
'B' - Good	3.50-4.49	55-64
'C' - Average	2.50-3.49	45-54
'D' - Below Average	1.50-2.49	35-44
'E' - Poor	0.50-1.49	25-34
'F' - Fail	0-0.49	0-24
